Overview paragraph: This VBS is an answer to those smaller churches that really can't pull off a huge 5-day event. This program is designed with a simple theme for the  $2\frac{1}{2}$  days that they gather – God loves us, so...*love each other*! There are two Bible stories – 4 friends bring their friend to Jesus to heal and Jesus dies and comes back to life. There are several craft, game and service project options for each age level on each day. There is no snack rotation since the time together is only  $2\frac{1}{2}$  hours. The final day can be incorporated into a regular Sunday morning church service or be used as a stand-alone program. There are only 6 songs used during the program but they are upbeat and the CD is only \$4.99!

- This program would be good for a church that's thinking about doing VBS for the first time or if they have limited number of volunteers. It's a 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> day program that can be easily adapted to morning, evening, or weekend programming.
- They do give you some options and flexibility with the crafts/service projects.
- Since the time commitment is reduced, you don't need as many volunteers as you would for a full week program.

# Weaknesses:

- One of the crafts involves glitter with the preschoolers usually not a good combination!
- The service projects could be costly if you went out and bought the materials that are to be included in them, but that could be offset with a church/community awareness offering of those materials.

The week will be spent discovering the rich treasure of God's love and Jesus' life surrounded by a beach/tropical theme. The 5 daily points are solid ones – God's love is giving; God's love is kind; God's love is caring; God's love is forgiving; and God's love is forever. The stories used are familiar ones and told in an age-developmental way. Gospel Light does a good job of making sure the message of God's love and saving grace is evident in all their lessons without being overbearing.

- This is truly the reproducible VBS! The Director's Manual has a CD that has everything and anything that you could think of for your VBS training articles, forms, checklists, newsletters, and some of them are modifiable. You can also purchase the Reproducible Power Pack that has all the leader resources and guides to be printed (\$99.99).
- The craft book is a treasure trove includes 46 crafts for the week that you can pick and choose depending on age and theme.
- You can either do this VBS as a rotation model or a classroom model. The games and bible story centers are separated into 3 age groups Primary, Middler, and Preteen. Some of the centers are combined such as opening and closing, crafts, and snacks
- The music is reproducible also though there are only 6 songs with 2 additional preschool songs.
- Decorating will be easy beach theme with sand and water!
- Does have a nighttime VBS guide included in the deluxe kit.
- Offered more than one snack/food item for each day. Did tend more towards sugary snacks than healthy for main selections.

# Weaknesses:

- Not a huge selection of music only 6 songs with 2 additional ones for preschoolers.
- A lot of materials to go through on the discs but they do have them categorized in folders which helps somewhat.
- Snacks were a bit heavy on the sugary side but options were available.

The 5 stories/themes are God is CREATOR (story of creation), God is PROVIDER (story of Elijah), God is PROTECTOR (Daniel in the lion's den), God is SAVIOR (death and resurrection), and God is KING (story of John on Patmos). Standard has introduced two new sites in addition to the traditional ones – Crafts & Music where musical instruments are made to go with the lyrics and motions of the songs and Service & Missions where kids learn to impact their community and the world through activities and projects joined with either ongoing missions in your church or ones from Back2Back Ministries.

# Weaknesses:

- Some of the crafts are not developmentally appropriate they are too complicated for the ages given.
- Snacks tend to be more on the sugary side than healthy.

Overview paragraph: **Wilderness Escape** is Group's latest "time-travel" VBS. This year it is an exciting journey with God's people, the Israelites, and Moses as they escape Egypt and have God provide and guide them through the desert. Moses is the central character that will interact with the participants each day – exploring an exciting adventure each day including:

Day 1 – God is with us; the Israelites cross the Red Sea.

Day 2 - God gives us what we need; God provides manna and quail.

Day 3 – God gives us strength; Israel defeats the Amalekites.

Day 4 – God saves us; Moses remembers Passover.

Day 5 – God guides us; God gives the Ten Commandments.

Each day is spent in "tribes" made up of all ages and they travel around to the Israelite Camp, Moses' tent, Fun and Games and then gather together for opening and closing Tribe Time.

# Strengths:

- This is a great way to create an intergenerational VBS involving all ages to create tribes and experience Bible times together.
- Music is upbeat and energizing and easy to learn.
- You can pick and choose how many different shops you want in the Israelite camp area to meet the needs of your volunteers and participants.
- Only need 3 trained station leaders Music/Gathering; Moses, and Games.
- Does have a mission project included for present-day clean water for children in India.
- They have included preschool-friendly options this year.
- This program can easily be adapted for use at other times like Lenten programs.

- Can be very expensive if all the extras are purchased things like the tribe flags and tote bags, but these can be made or duplicated without going to a huge expense.
- Can be a bit campy at times such as using Peeps for quail but sometimes fun is good.

- Music is not reproducible as the rights are owned by the original artists or other publishers but they have lowered the prices of the CDs for distribution as low as \$4.99/100.
- Crafts/activities in the Israelite Camp can be expensive to purchase though you might be able to substitute similar ones.

Overview paragraph: **Gangway to Galilee** is a traditional style VBS in that their main message is the Gospel and God's message of saving grace. Each day the concept of sin and Jesus' saving grace is discussed in relation to the 5 stories. All 5 stories for the week are from the New Testament based around the Sea of Galilee and its shore – Jesus calls his disciples; Jesus teaches from the boat; Jesus calms the storm; Jesus walks on water; and Jesus appears to seven disciples. Each day has its own simple take-home point that all can learn and memorize. It is a rotation model with groups of kids rotating to each center, though preschoolers are kept separate from the elementary groups.

# Strengths:

- The snacks were a good balance between healthy and sugary also had alternative snacks for a few of the days.
- Decorating will be easy and not too expensive beach theme and water all easily available in the summer.
- The starter kit is almost complete, even comes with poster sets! Does include CDs with all the power point presentations, .pdf files for reproduction, music DVD, etc.
- Has a separate overview for the pastor/minister. It concisely lists all the activities, stories, and how he/she can support the VBS and staff.

- The music doesn't have much personality. All the songs sound very similar and repetitive. It does have a list of alternative hymns for music is desired.
- There is daily emphasis on "sin". It's never really defined but the image of not being good enough is stressed. This could be hard for some children to comprehend.

- The mission project doesn't have anything tangible for the kids. They are asked to bring money in for churches in other countries and shown pictures of what their money might be used for.
- Crafts aren't too imaginative coloring and gluing.

Overview paragraph:

At the Workshop of Wonders, children will discover the wonder of God all around us. The children will see how the ordinary becomes extraordinary with God, see how people in the Old and New Testaments used what they had to do extraordinary things with God, and use their own hearts, minds and imaginations to serve God. The daily themes of Imagine with God, Build with God, Grow with God, Work with God and Walk with God all lead the children through stories in the Bible that can then be applied to their own growing relationship with Jesus. This program is designed to help kids see that even the things they might not consider important can be used by God to do the amazing. It is all about how God can use us to create WOW moments for God's glory!

# Strengths:

• Very adaptable. You can do this in a week, in a month, even one day. They provide a good range of time based schedules as well (2 hour, 3 hour, rotation model, etc)

- Stories are a good balance of OT and NT
- Songs are well written, easy to learn but fun for kids and adults
- Both Science and Craft have multiple options for each day
- Leader's guides provide ample information, suggestions, and support
- Webpage, FB page, blog and Pintrest page have great ideas from churches

• Mega Media Pak provides separate disks for Music, Assembly and Decorating, allowing different leaders to all have access.

# Weaknesses:

- Crafts can be pricey, however they do offer low cost alternatives
- Graphics and Titles are not as WOW as they could be. I often tell people "it's better than the name implies!"
- Some of the extras can be quite pricey, such as the banners or the preprinted materials. However, you can adapt and not use the preprinted materials
- When doing shorter options, reflection time can be left out. Leaders would need to ensure that students are discussing the Bible message throughout the session time.

*Weird Animals: Where Jesus' Love Is One of a Kind* Group VBS 800-447-1070 group.com/vbs Starter Kit cost: \$169

The main emphasis of the *Weird Animals* VBS program is the Jesus' love for all people, no matter how different they may be. Activities each day are centered on a Bible story, which, for the most part, are appropriate for children. The one exception is the general story on the fourth day about the death and resurrection of Jesus, with emphasis on the two criminals who were crucified with him. Some of the suggested dialogue is heavy-handed, with a strong emphasis on "wrongdoings." Even the snack reinforces this theme with a comparison to the "bitterness" of cinnamon to sin, which is "gross." For the most part, however, the love of Jesus is the focus of activities, music, and storytelling.

Each day is well-planned, with a gathering for all ages and a "Tail End" that brings everyone back together at the end of the program for songs and to review the theme for the day. The "KidVid Stories" bring diversity to any VBS setting with films about real children facing issues such as nontraditional families, autism, leukemia, bullying, and facing fear. Thoughtful leaders should be able to use the basic materials in *Weird Animals* to create a week of fun and learning for children in their community.

## Strengths:

- The Starter Kit includes most of the materials needed for a VBS, if leaders are creative and can substitute their own craft creations and decorating props.
- The materials are user friendly, designed for a range of leaders from first timers to those with extensive VBS experience.
- Churches can create their own VBS website with free software to promote, register and organize their programs.
- Additional ideas and support for Weird Animals are available on the Group VBS website.
- The music is a notch above many VBS offerings. The words emphasize hope and love and the music itself is upbeat. The music CD comes with vocal and instrumental selections, while a separate DVD can be used to teach children motions to go with the songs.
- The mission component, a money-raiser to provide clean water in India, will help children learn about the importance of water and its scarcity throughout the world.

- If leaders purchase additional student and decorating resources, this program is very pricey.
- The materials are over-scripted in many cases; even the person making snacks is told what to say.
- The mission component costs \$50 or more to set up and basically encourages children to bring in money. A more hands-on approach for a community organization might be a better way to teach children about helping others.

- Scripts for stories and other materials may need to be rewritten to reflect the beliefs of the sponsoring congregation.
- The cost of cheaply-made plastic "gizmos" for the Imagination Station is about \$3.70 per child for the week. A better idea would be to create a science station that uses everyday materials. Dorothy Linthicum

This creative intergenerational curriculum uses C.S. Lewis' beloved fantasy *The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe* to explore theology. A 5-day lesson plan makes it suitable for VBS.

C.S. Lewis wrote the Narnia series "as an unconscious preparation of the imagination" to explore the deep power of faith and belief. Acting in the imagination prepares us to respond in faithful ways when in our real lives we are confronted with meanness and treachery.

Themes of the five days are:

Day 1: Discovery of Narnia: how ideas about reality color behavior.

Day 2: Discovery of the Beavers and the abiding hope that Aslan will return: how values lead to action.

Day 3: Father Christmas and Spring return; Aslan greets the troop at the Stone Table, and Peter wins his first battle: how fear and love affect actions, and the power of forgiveness and reconciliation.

Day 4: Aslan and the Witch strike a bargain: the meaning of a willing sacrifice, abiding belief, grief and joy.

Day 5: Joy of Coronation: how this adventure expresses truth and reality for us and connects to familiar celebrations.

A mission project of the Presbyterian Synod of Living Waters, *Clean Water for All God's Children* is designed to enable children to understand the importance of clean water for health, and to show them ways to share in the mission of taking clean water to all the children of the world. The material can simply raise awareness of the world's great need for clean water, or it may educate a church that is preparing to send a team on an international mission trip. Each of the five days includes an opening time (with skit or puppet show and water conservation emphasis), a Bible story, a mission focus, activities/crafts, recreation and snacks, music and drama, and a closing time. Designed as a low-cost, thoughtful curriculum, all material in the basic notebook may be duplicated for use in the congregation's VBS program. A separate outline is provided for a preschool section, though younger children may join others during music time.

Daily themes center on God's use of water:

1. The Creation	- the goodness of water
2. The Crossing of the Red Sea	- water for salvation
3. The Healing of Naaman	- water for healing
4. The Baptism of Jesus	- water as a sign of grace
5. The Woman at the Well	- water for physical needs

- No recommendations on snacks are provided.
- Few photos or graphics provided; photos show only children from Latin American countries.

- L'Engle's book, a best-seller for more than 50 years, is grounded in Christian tradition and theology, mixing faith and science, religion and fiction
- Staffing may be easier when using a beloved children's book as the VBS theme.
- There is room for great creativity.
- Children are introduced to yoga, a valuable resource.

- No information is provided about securing public performance rights for showing a feature-length film, or how to acquire the film.
- Instructions for crafts and snacks are minimal, as is information on organizing the week.
- Many adults (or youth) with acting talents are required.
- There is no suggested mission/outreach focus.
- Music consists of a simple list of titles, without reference to specific hymnals or songbooks.

*Festival of Faith* invites children and adults to take part in the story of the Christian faith as it unfolds through the seasons of the Church Year. Each of the five days is devoted to a different season in the Church Year: Advent and Christmas; Epiphany; Lent and Easter; Pentecost; and Kingdomtide, also known as Ordinary Time or Late Pentecost. For each season there is a theme, scripture passage, and memory verse.

Children gain an understanding of the church as a global community through the activities in the lesson plans. Children are grouped according to "Embassies," representing countries from the Americas, Africa, Europe and Asia. Through the daily crafts and snacks children learn the customs of different countries. In large group opening and closing sessions, children learn the day's theme and Bible story. The format includes an optional Ethnic Festival and Open House final program.

Age Levels: Children are placed in cross-age groups.

(The program is ungraded; appears suitable for grades Kindergarten -6.)

*Pilgrimage* transports students into the Middle Ages to journey as pilgrims to sites where they learn from the lives of people of faith. The Middle Ages stand out as a time when Christians journeyed in faith to distant locations as a way to deepen their experience of God and others.

On this pilgrimage, participants travel to the ultimate destination for God's faithful people: the Kingdom of God. Over five sessions, children find a road map that helps them to know themselves and others in new ways as they seek to know God as Creator, Savior and Holy Spirit.

Participants travel to five sites that were common destinations for medieval pilgrims: Rome, Italy; Canterbury, England; Santiago de Campostela, Spain; Dumfermline, Scotland; and Croagh Patrick, Ireland. Each day features not only a different destination but a different saint: St. Peter, Thomas Becket, James the Greater, Margaret of Scotland, and St. Patrick.

The heart of the daily experience is the Street Fair. Children become bakers, bookbinders, clothiers, painters, needle workers, stonemasons, woodworkers, and storytellers. As such, they participate in activities that are linked to the theme for the day. Guilds of students then meet to discuss their experiences in the Street Fair. The day closes with community singing, prayer, and worship.

**ReNew** is an environmentally-focused VBS program that inspires children and adults to grow in faith, have fun, and change the world as they practice stewardship of creation. Designed as a traditional, rotation-based Vacation Bible School, **ReNew** has modified and simplified the program to make it green. Using Jesus' *Parable of the Sower*, participants look at the story from perspectives of Self, Community, and World.

Daily themes:

- Planting Seeds
- Taking Root
- Growing
- Facing Challenges
- Living Together

**ReNew** has made a deliberate effort to teach and to practice good stewardship of the earth throughout this program. The curriculum, from reproducible pages to music CD's, is manufactured from recycled materials. Inks are soy-based an items often have more than one use, allowing for low-waste planning. Tips for caring for the earth are everywhere, drawing from the Bible as well as from the latest climate science. It is a fascinating and creative effort to "walk the talk" about taking care of God's creation.

This vacation Bible experience is based on the children's story book *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* and the 1971 version of the movie, *Willie Wonka and the Chocolate Factory*. The curriculum examines the five children who are characters in the story and their character traits, which are then related to the sins of Greed, Pride, Envy and Sloth. The story of the Prodigal Son (*Luke 15:11-24*) is the biblical basis for the program. Charlie, the main character who exhibits the traits of hard work, caring, sharing, honesty, and repentance, is compared to the prodigal son at the end of the story when he asks for forgiveness from his grandfather.

This Vacation Bible Experience uses the popular Harry Potter character to explore theologically life's journey as a path to the inner self and to the Creator. The curriculum connects Harry Potter's experiences and Biblical teachings. For example, the New Testament teaches that the Kingdom of Heaven is all around us and in us, and Jesus advises: "Let he who has ears hear and he who has eyes see." Likewise, in the Harry Potter books, the Wizarding World – representing magic with its possibilities for transformation – is all around and in the midst of the Muggles, but they do not see it.
